I'm sorry to say that as far as COVID-19 is concerned, we are not getting off to a very good start for the year 2021.

Sunday, January 10<sup>th</sup>, one of our employees was home and not feeling well, she was lucky enough to get a doctor appointment, end result, she tested positive for COVID-19. The employee was removed from the schedule.

Monday morning, January 11<sup>th</sup>, one of our Harborview residents tested positive for COVID-19. As a precaution, all residents received a rapid COVID test. Two (2) residents from Tidewater Cove tested positive. The three (3) positive residents were moved to Mallard Way, our unit designated for COVID patients only.

According to the Food and Drug Administration the coronavirus vaccine made by Pfizer that our residents & staff received on January 7<sup>th</sup> starts to provide protection against Covid-19 within about 10 days after the first dose. The second dose is scheduled to be given at CCRC on January 28<sup>th</sup>.
