To Residents and Family Members:

As the month of January 2022 winds down, the number of COVID cases per week also has been winding down at CCRC. For this last week we had no residents test positive and 1 employee test positive for COVID. Today is **day 40** of the current COVID Outbreak that started on Dec. 20th.

The visitor testing that started on Friday, January 21st continues. Point of Care (POC) Tests are performed prior to entering the facility and the results are good for 3 days. Specimen collection is done by the visitor. Only visitors with Negative test results will be allowed entrance, even with negative testing, all visitors must be screened for symptoms on arrival. Testing takes approximately 15 minutes.

The level of community transmission in Harford County is still HIGH, actually the level of community transmission is HIGH for the entire United States.

Booster Clinic – The National Guard will be helping us with our Booster Clinic on February 9th from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm. First & Second vaccines will also be available. Residents and Staff are eligible to receive vaccinations at no cost.

We encourage family members to continue to connect with their loved ones through Zoom, Google Duo, FaceTime, texting, or plain old telephone call. To setup a time, please contact Pam or Jocie at 410-942-2126.
