To Residents and Family Members:

Update of COVID-19 activity since our last communication –

We have not had any residents or employees test positive since our last communication on January 28th. Our last resident to test positive was on January 7, 2022. Our last employee to test positive was on January 25, 2022. Today is **day 50** of the current COVID Outbreak that started on Dec. 20th. During the outbreak, at a minimum, residents are tested for COVID every 5 to 7 days and employees are tested for COVID twice per week. Residents & employees are also tested if they are exhibiting COVID symptoms.

The level of community transmission in Harford County is still HIGH. The positivity rate in Harford County is 10.4%, down from 17.8% last week.

The National Guard will be at Citizens Care this Wednesday, February 9th from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm. for Boosters, First & Second vaccines for Residents and Staff. There is no out of pocket cost for the vaccinations.

We encourage family members to continue to connect with their loved ones through Zoom, Google Duo, FaceTime, texting, or a plain old telephone call. To setup a time, please contact Pam or Jocie at 410-942-2126.
