To Residents and Family Members:

Update on COVID-19 –

We have GOOD NEWS to report, as of Wednesday, February 9th, the COVID Outbreak that started on December 20, 2021 officially ended. As such, residents will no longer be routinely tested for COVID every 5 to 7 days.

The positivity rate in Harford County is 7.9%, down from 10.2% last week. The level of community transmission in Harford County remains HIGH.

The importance of staying Up to Date with your vaccines --

In general, all residents who are not **up to date** with all recommended COVID-19 vaccine doses and are new admissions or readmissions (e.g. returning from the hospital) will be placed in quarantine for 10 days on River Walk, even if they have a negative test upon admission or readmission.

Up to date means a person has received all recommended COVID-19 vaccines, including any booster dose(s) when eligible.

Fully vaccinated means a person has received their primary series of COVID-19 vaccines.

We encourage family members to continue to connect with their loved ones through Zoom, Google Duo, FaceTime, texting, or telephone call. To setup a time, please contact Pam or Jocie at 410-942-2126.
