We have Good News to report at CCRC

As of Monday, February 22, 2021, we have tested residents, staff & contractors for COVID-19 for 14 days and all tests were negative. This 14 days with no new onset of COVID-19 will end our most recent outbreak.

As stated in the February 19th communication, visitation will resume in March, 2021. We will actually start visitation on Tuesday, March 2, 2021. Visitation days will be Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM each day. Our Director of Activities, Jocie Silver will manage the visitation plan.

1. Visitors are screened for symptoms and not permitted to visit, if symptomatic.
2. Visitors will receive a COVID-19 POC Test at the Riverwalk entrance immediately prior to visiting a resident. PCR tests are no longer required.
3. Only visitors with a negative POC test result will be allowed to visit.
4. Visitors and residents must wear a face covering at all times.
5. Hand Hygiene is performed before and after each visit.
6. Visitors and residents maintain proper social distancing at all times. Physical contact is not allowed during visits. Residents may be placed on observation if appropriate distancing is not maintained.
7. Items in the visitation area are cleaned and disinfected between visits.
8. A staff member is present to ensure resident safety and appropriate adherence to guidelines. Visitors who do not comply with safety recommendations (e.g. masking and social distancing) will be asked to leave.
9. A maximum of 2 visitors are allowed per resident per visit.

10. The Local health department may decide to pause visitation if deemed necessary.
11. A copy of the Updated Visitation Policy is attached.

Update on COVID-19 test results for residents, employees and contractors on Thursday, February 25th.

Since February 19th, we have had 100% negative test results for residents, employees & contractors. Looking back, our last positive COVID-19 test result was 18 days ago on February 7th.
