COVID Update since March 7<sup>th</sup> communication --

We received a positive PCR test result on a contract worker Wednesday, March 9<sup>th</sup>. The contract worker was last in the facility Tuesday, March 8<sup>th</sup>. Appropriate COVID testing was completed, all were negative. We now have a total of 2 residents & 1 contract worker showing **POSITIVE** for COVID. We are currently in **Isolated Outbreak Mode on the Riverwalk unit**. Harborview, Bay Lane and Tidewater Cove will function as normal. Mask should be worn.

Beauty shop will be open to Harborview, Bay Lane and Tidewater Cove residents.

Residents & staff will be POC tested weekly for the next two weeks.

Visitors continue to be tested at this time.

**REMINDER --**

The entrance facing Market Street is for **EMPLOYEES ONLY**. Everyone else will enter/exit the facility using the **RIVERWALK ENTRANCE** accessed via the parking lot off Revolution Street. This includes visitors, vendors, ambulance pickup & drop-off, families picking up residents for trips & appointments away from the facility, new admissions, 911, etc.
