To Residents and Family Members:

We received word Tuesday afternoon, May 11th that one of our Long Term Care residents that has been in the hospital since May 3rd has now tested positive for COVID-19. The resident tested negative on admission to the hospital on May 3rd and was tested again at the hospital on May 10th and tested positive.

Upon notice of the positive COVID-19 test result on Tuesday, we PCR tested all residents for COVID-19. We expect to receive results from the PCR testing by Friday of this week. Going forward, we will continue testing residents weekly until we have 14 days of testing cycles with no new positive test results.

As a result of this positive test result, visitation will be paused Wednesday & Friday and will resume on Saturday pending results of the COVID-19 testing.

All employees, volunteers & contractors will continue to be tested two times per week, Mondays & Thursdays.

We are still accepting requests from residents & staff to get the COVID-19 vaccination, residents should notify their nurse if they would like to receive the COVID-19 vaccination.

Stay safe & vaccinate.
