To Residents and Family Members:

On Thursday of this week, October 14th, we collected COVID-19 testing samples from unvaccinated staff and consultants. One employee tested positive. The employee that tested positive last worked at CCRC on Wednesday, October 13th. This employee was removed from the schedule.

When a new case of COVID-19 among residents or staff is identified, we are required to immediately begin outbreak testing and suspend all visitation until at least one round of facility-wide PCR testing is completed. If the first round of PCR testing reveals no additional COVID-19 cases, then visitation can resume. If the first round of PCR testing reveals one or more additional COVID-19 cases. Then visitation will remain suspended (vaccinated and unvaccinated), until we meet the criteria to discontinue outbreak testing. We are now required to test residents and staff weekly until we have 2 weeks of testing cycles with no new positive test results. If we have no new positives in that period we can discontinue testing residents.

Our COVID Committee continues to closely monitor COVID-19 and staying abreast of updates from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), and the local and state health department. We will continue to update you routinely until this current outbreak is resolved. Thank you for your patience and support as we continue to safeguard our residents and staff.
