To Residents and Family Members:

UPDATE FROM BELOW CURRENTLY 4:08PM: We have 108 of 110 resident test samples back with 107 negative and one positive. The resident has been moved off of the long term care unit and placed on our isolation COVID-19 unit. The resident is asymptomatic.

On Friday, August 28, 2020, we were notified that 3 (three) employees tested positive for COVID-19. One of these samples was collected Monday August 24, 2020 and two of these samples were collected on Tuesday August 25, 2020. All three of these employees are asymptomatic and were immediately removed from the schedule after we were notified of their results.

On August 24th & 25th COVID-19 testing was completed for 182 staff and contractors. At this time 152 are negative, 3 (three) are positive and we are still awaiting results on 27 employee samples.

On August 25th & 26th COVID-19 testing was completed for 110 residents. 51 of those resident samples are negative. We are still awaiting results from the lab on 59 resident samples.

COVID-19 testing for last week, the week of August 17th was 100% negative for both staff and residents.

Due to this week's recent positives we will remain under outbreak precautions and will need to continue to test the staff and residents until we have two weeks of 100% negatives.

This has been such a complicated and difficult time for so many. We have been meeting here at the facility over the past two weeks and discussing ways to support our residents, their care and staffing. We plan on sharing updates on this topic with you next week. COVID-19 has impacted us in so many ways. I am grateful that all staff and residents remain asymptomatic and feeling healthy. Their health is our number one priority. We will follow up with communication of the outstanding testing samples as soon as we receive them.

Thank you for your continued patience and support.

We continue to closely monitor COVID-19 and staying abreast of updates from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), and local and state health departments.
